Nagoya Campus

The Nagoya campus is located in Yagoto, the eastern hilly area of Nagoya City known as the city's most outstanding academic district. It has eight Schools, seven Graduate Schools, MBA and Law School, and is directly connected to the Yagoto Subway Station which means it has good access to the downtown area of Nagoya City. The Nagoya Campus has 20 buildings including the nine-story Center Building. The huge atrium "Galleria" located in it is a place where students can meet and relax.

Toyota Campus

The Toyota Campus is located in the hilly area of Toyota City. Toyota City is well known as home to Toyota Motor Corporation headquarter and factories. The Toyota Campus has three Schools and three Graduate Schools. On its large campus there are various types of sports facilities including athletic grounds, baseball field, soccer grounds and swimming pool. In particular Ice Arena for figure skating is officially designated as a National Training Center. The Toyota Campus has produced many world-class athletes including Miki Ando, Takehiko Kozuka, Mao Asada (figure skating) and Naoya Tomita (swimming).



History

Chukyo University opened its doors in 1956 when Chukyo Junior College, Department of Business, was established. Before the foundation of Chukyo University, Umemura Group of Educational Institutions which Chukyo University belongs to started the Chukyo School of Commerce in 1923. Chukyo University was founded on the educational experience which the Chukyo School of Commerce had built up. Since then we, Chukyo University, have opened new departments which set trends for the new era one after another. Currently we have eleven Schools, ten Graduate Schools, MBA and Law School. We have two campuses, Nagoya Campus and Toyota Campus. The number of students currently attending is more than 13 thousand in both campuses and we are one of the largest private universities in Japan. We have so far graduated more than 100 thousand students. They play an active role in industry, public and educational circles.

Philosophy

Our institution's goal of providing "a focus of excellence in both learning and sports" was the philosophy of our founder and continues to inspire and inform our activities today. It means that the mind and the body are essentially indivisible and both should be developed in harmony. This philosophy is embodied as four broad outlines using analogies from the sport world: "Obey the rules", "Try your best", "Promote teamwork", and "Have a respectful attitude". Our philosophy is continuously stressed and upheld among our graduates and students.
