① At the second year of Master's Program, tuition fee, educational supplement fee (or conference fee), and experiment and practical training fee are the same amount as the first year (enrollment fee is not required)

② At the second year and third year of Doctoral Program, tuition fee, educational supplement fee, and experiment and practical training fee are the same amount as the first year (enrollment fee is not required)

③ Enrollment fee is only required at the first year of the program

Tuition fee, educational supplement fee, and experiment and practical training fee are invoiced divided into twice in Spring semester and Fall semester

The amount of total at enrollment includes enrollment fee, half price of tuition fee, half price of educational supplement fee, and half price of experiment and practical training fee (or conference fee) for Spring semester

④ All international students are applied for waiving of 30% of tuition fee at 2 years of Master's Program and 3 years of Doctoral Program

⑤ By cancelling before the deadline date for the cancellation of enrollment, fees are refunded except for enrollment fee
