Archive access:

Document copying:

Photocopies of materials not owned by Chukyo University can be ordered. Please apply via OPAC.

Fees for copying and postage should be paid by the applicants.

Interlibrary loan:

Books not owned by Chukyo University Library an be ordered.

"This does not apply to magazines."

Please apply via OPAC.

Fees for two-way postage should be paid by the applicants.

Letters of introduction:

Introduction letters are issued to use other universities and institutions libraries if necessary. Please apply at the counter one week prior to the date you are planning to visit.



Please take good care of library materials.

Please observe the return date for borrowed materials.

Please be silent and refrain from chatting in a loud voices inside the libraries.

Speaking on mobile phones is prohibited.

Eating and drinking in the libraries is prohibited as a rule; however, drinks with lids (Plastic bottles, flasks) are permitted.
